All of the services will have several priests available to hear confessions. The Church requires that we receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least one time per year with more frequent receptions of the Sacrament encouraged.

Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence**During Lent**

FASTING means eating a lesser amount of food. While fasting, only full meal is eaten. Two smaller meals are eaten both the amount of these two should not exceed one full meal. No food is eaten between meals. Catholics 18-59 years of age are asked to observe two fast days during Lent, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

ABSTINENCE means not eating any meat. Dairy products and fish are allowed. All Catholics over the age of 14 are required to abstain. Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

ON ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY, WE BOTH FAST AND ABSTAIN.

Not all may be able to observe the above regulations because of health or other reasons. Persons legitimately excused from the laws of fast and abstinence are urged to practice other forms of penance and self-denial suitable to their condition.

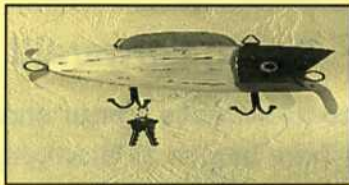

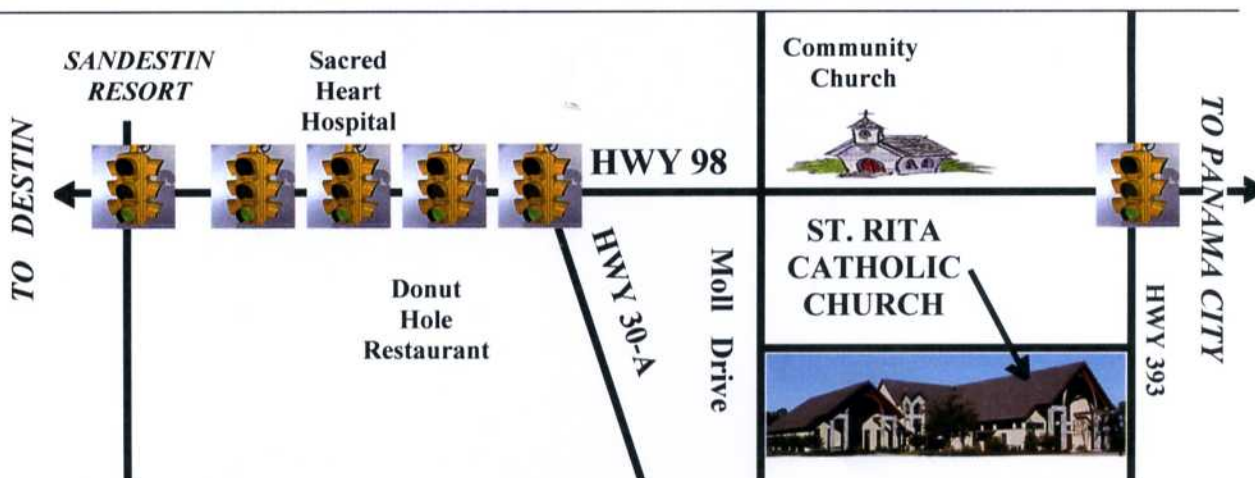
