The fifteen members of our Saint Vincent DePaul Conference accomplished much during the second quarter of 2011. We drove 1,737 miles, volunteered 241 hours, made 62 home visits, and helped 123 people. During this time we used \$17,459 you have so generously donated to help families and individuals with late rent payments, groceries, utility bills, and medical care. We also successfully helped an individual apply for pharmaceutical company assistance for long-term medication.

During these three months we have continued our partnership with neighboring Resurrection Parish in Miramar Beach. Resurrection parishioners have contributed significant funds and volunteers to assist us in serving the needy in South Walton County.

This month our St. Rita Conference elected a new president and a slate of officers to be installed for a three-year term in September.
