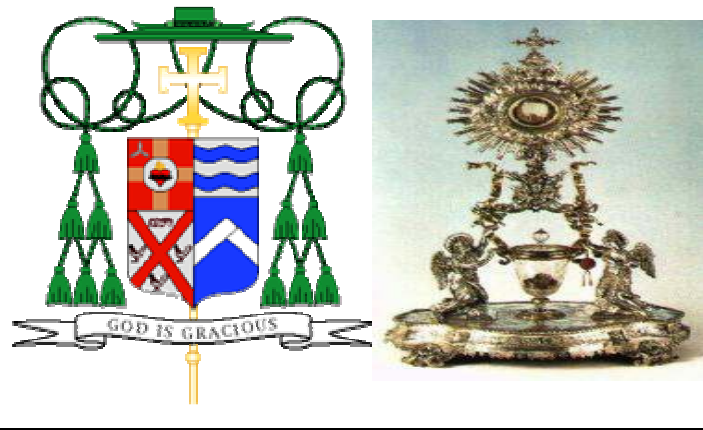



GOD'S WORK
