## Annual Report

The twenty members of our Saint Vincent DePaul Conference accomplished much during our past annual year October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011. We drove 6,447 miles, volunteered 654 hours, made 210 home visits, and helped 506 people.

Our beginning bank balance at October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 was \$11,848. During our annual year we had donations from: Our Members \$3,469, Church/Poor Box \$3,264, Door Collections after Mass \$35,561, Resurrection Church \$18,655, and Other Donations \$3,042 (Men's Club and Greyhound Refund) which totaled \$63,791.

Our continued three-year partnerships with Resurrection parishioners in Miramar Beach have contributed significant funds and volunteers to assist us in serving the needy in South Walton County.

During our annual year we had disbursements: Clients We Helped \$62,152, this represents 97% of all donations. We helped these families and individuals with late rent payments, groceries, utility bills, medicines, medical bills, gas, and etc. Our overhead represents 3% of all donations: Dues to Councils \$1,180, Contributions to Upper Councils \$1,400 (Disaster Relief and Solidarity Fund), Operational Expenses \$272 (Spiritual Inspiration Books & DVD, Checks), and Other Expenses \$20 (Mass Father Tom) which totaled \$2,872. Our total disbursements for our annual year totaled \$65,024.

Our ending balance as of September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011 was \$10,615. This balance has already been put to good use in the first few weeks of this month.

We had several In Kind Goods and Services Given also: We had people moving and donated their pantry, refrigerator, and freezer items to a needed family. We had over 15 bags of groceries we distributed. We helped clients who needed to move. We helped clients apply for and receive \$3,684 of free prescriptions.
