Tom O'Hare reported the cost to make a rigid PVC board with vinyl lettering for Easter Mass schedule to hang over the Mass schedule sign at the entrance off Moll Drive is \$80.00.

Tom O'Hare reported the cost to replace the current three slats St. Rita sign at Moll Drive and Hwy. 98 with a larger double faced one slat sign is \$200.00. Tom said one piece signs are not approved by Walton County and recommended keeping the old three piece sign. Father Tom asked to see a copy of Walton Counties sign ordinance. Mike Klein will e-mail Father Tom a link to the Counties sign ordinance on their web site.

Tom O'Hare said his son Brian will make stencils and donate to St.Rita for labeling the new roasters "property of St. Rita Parish" so Bob Borella can sleep at night knowing the Parish cooking equipment is secure.

### **New Business**

Tom O'Hare reported the CCW is in the process of obtaining a special Rose colored outer Vestment for Father Tom that is used two Sundays of the year, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent and the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent. The CCW is requesting the Men's Club support of up to \$250.00 for this project.

November 2009 Monthly Meeting**

The meeting is called to order by President Tom O'Hare. Father Tom led the opening prayer.

Tom O'Hare introduced two new members of St. Rita Parish and the Men's club, John Thompson and Chuck Thompson.

Minutes from the last meeting of 15 October 2009 were read by Michael Klein and amended to say 'January 11, 2010 is called the Snowbird Breakfast and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Fish Fry dinner is on January 29, 2010.' Bob Borella made a motion to accept the minutes as read and amended, seconded by Gene Fowler and carried.

Treasurers Report was presented by President Tom O'Hare for Treasurer Vern Quast. The balance from 15 October 2009 was \$5,733.87 .Distributions were \$67.64 for cake from Sam's Club and \$39. 87 for two roasters purchased by Joe Colello for the Men's Club and St. Rita use. The balance is \$5,626.36. Bob Borella made a motion to accept the Treasurers Report seconded by John Thompson and carried.

**Old Business**

Father Tom reported Father Pete is finalizing the details of the sponsorship costs for the Sunday 10:00 am St. Dominic cable TV Mass and the Catholic in America program. Father Tom has a sponsor and will make a presentation to the Men's Club in January. St. Rita has made a commitment of \$3,000.00 to support Father Pete. Jim Kelly said he also has a potential real estate investor interested in a sponsorship.

Chick Huettel reported Dave Delahoussaye has revised his bid for the Confessional Project and lowered it by deducting his own labor cost. Revised bid is \$3,500.00 to \$3,700.00. Bob Borella said we should not ask him to do the work without compensation for his time. He also said we should wait until after the first Fish Fry Dinner to start the project because there was only \$3,000.00 placed in reserve for the project and we will need funding of expenses for the Snowbird Breakfast and the first Fry dinner. Joe Colello said the first Fish Fry dinner expenses normally run from \$1,800.00 to \$2,000.00. Father Tom said the goal is to have the Confessional ready for Lent so it could be used during Mass if another Priest is available. The project could start now, but no work would be done in the Church until after Christmas. Jim Kelly made a motion to proceed with the project, seconded by Ron Michalak and carried.

Bob Borella said he will have the new wooded Cross completed by Lent.
