What is restored Order?

For a variety of historical and pastoral reasons, Confirmation and reception of Holy Communion began to occur later in the lives of Catholic children in many parts of the world. During the first decade of the 20th century, Pope St. Pius X sought to reverse course on this gradual drift by exhorting pastors across the globe to allow children as young as 7 or 8 to receive Holy Communion. At the same time he did not specifically address Confirmation and as a result many dioceses continued to delay that sacrament until late adolescence, several years after children had received their First Holy Communion.

Over a century later, the Holy Spirit has been stirring a desire throughout the Church to restore the order of the sacraments of initiation. A number of bishops have taken the step to lower the age of Confirmation to ages 7-8 (the age of discretion) and require that Eucharist be the final sacrament of initiation given to baptized Catholics. By early 2028 this will be the normal practice in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee.
