O come, O come, Emmanuel

Among the perennial wonderings of the Advent Season is why the beloved liturgical hymn "O come, O come, Emmanuel" is set in a minor key. Composers use this scale, among other reasons, to create tension or longing. This familiar melody, then, frequently sung during Masses in anticipation of Christmas, elicits a distinct emotional atmosphere.

In truth, the Advent Season is characterized by expectation, as it is the observance of the two-fold purpose of waiting to commemorate Jesus's first coming as well as anticipating His second coming. With hope in the redemption of Christ we yearn for his arrival.

At the same time, we know that the Kingdom of God already reigns. We can experience salvation in the moment of now. Thus the Advent Season portends an encounter with Jesus which is accompanied with delight.

In this way, our familiar hymn is also an ode to joy. This reality, as well, is captured by our familiar chant as we are called to "rejoice."
